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**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- “Fog” Moments: Leah shared, “Just because I cannot see the Alps doesn’t mean they’re not there.” Where in your life right now does it feel hard to see God clearly? What helps you keep trusting He’s still present in those moments?
- Knowing vs. Living Like God Is Present: We often believe God is with us, but don’t always live like it. What’s a practical difference you notice between those two? When have you caught yourself forgetting His presence in everyday life?
- God in the Boat Before the Storm Ends: The disciples thought Jesus showed up late, but He was already present. How does it change your perspective on struggles if God isn’t just arriving to fix things—but is already with you in them?
- Tables in Hard Places: Psalm 23 says God prepares a table in the presence of enemies.
- What might it look like for you to “sit” in a hard situation right now? What makes that difficult?
- From Knowing to Noticing: What are some simple ways you could train yourself this week to notice God’s goodness and love in your daily life?
